PROSTHODONTICS

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Hello!

My name is Dr. Julie Phillips. I am a dentist specializing in prosthodontics, the restoration and replacement of teeth to give you a better smile. Your dentist has recommended that you see me for certain services. I won't necessarily replace your current dentist, but will work with him or her to make sure you receive the best care possible.

What is a Prosthodontist?

Prosthodontics is one of the nine specialties recognized by the American Dental Association. The word prosthodontist comes from two Greek words: "prostho" which means "an addition" and "odonto" meaning "teeth." Put those two together and you get "additional teeth." In this case, it refers to providing you with additional teeth in the form of dentures, bridges and/or dental implants to replace the teeth you have lost, or improve your existing teeth.

After graduating from dental school, a prosthodontist receives an additional three years of specialty training which covers the techniques of cosmetic dentistry, dentures, veneers and implants. Prosthodontists also learn how to reconstruct the mouth after an injury or to correct problems for patients with dental challenges.

Who am I?

I grew up in northern New York State and received my doctorate degree from the dental school in Buffalo. I then did my prosthodontics residency at UNC-Chapel Hill, where I also received a Master's Degree for research I conducted on the effects of radiation on implant success rates. After completing my residency and receiving my specialist certification, I began practicing prosthodontics in Burlington before moving my practice to Greensboro in 2001.
